AN ACT

To amend chapter 307, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the crime of failure to lower tinted windows, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 307, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 307.174, to read as follows:

307.174. 1. A person commits the crime of failure to lower tinted

- 2 windows if such person is an occupant of a motor vehicle and fails to
- 3 fully lower any tinted windows, over which such person has automated
- 4 or manual control, upon the approach of a law enforcement officer who
- 5 has stopped the vehicle to investigate a traffic violation or other
- 6 criminal offense.
 - 2. Failure to lower tinted windows is a class C misdemeanor.
- 8 3. The provisions of this section shall not prevent a municipality
- 9 from enacting a local ordinance that creates the ordinance violation of
- 10 failure to lower tinted windows.
