## AN ACT

To repeal section 143.1004, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the Missouri military family relief fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 143.1004, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 143.1004, to read as follows:

143.1004. 1. In each taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2005,

2 each individual or corporation entitled to a tax refund in an amount sufficient to

3 make a designation under this section may designate that one dollar or any

4 amount in excess of one dollar on a single return, and two dollars or any amount

5 in excess of two dollars on a combined return, of the refund due be credited to the

3 Missouri military family relief fund. The contribution designation

authorized by this section shall be clearly and unambiguously printed

8 on each income tax return form provided by this state. If any individual

9 or corporation that is not entitled to a tax refund in an amount sufficient to make

10 a designation under this section wishes to make a contribution to the Missouri

11 military family relief fund, such individual or corporation may, by separate check,

12 draft, or other negotiable instrument, send in with the payment of taxes, or may

13 send in separately, that amount, clearly designated for the Missouri military

family relief fund, the individual or corporation wishes to contribute. The

15 department of revenue shall deposit such amount to the Missouri military family

16 relief fund as provided in subsection 2 of this section.

17 2. The director of revenue shall deposit at least monthly all contributions

designated by individuals under this section to the state treasurer for deposit to

the Missouri military family relief fund. The fund shall be administered by a

- 21 major of a reserve component or its equivalent, and a representative of the 22 Missouri veterans commission.
- 3. The director of revenue shall deposit at least monthly all contributions designated by the corporations under this section, less an amount sufficient to cover the cost of collection, handling, and administration by the department of revenue during fiscal year 2006, to the Missouri military family relief fund, not to exceed seventy thousand dollars.
- 4. A contribution designated under this section shall only be deposited in the Missouri military family relief fund after all other claims against the refund from which such contribution is to be made have been satisfied.
- 5. Moneys deposited in the Missouri military family relief fund shall be distributed by the adjutant general in accordance with the provisions of sections 41.216 and 41.218, RSMo.
- 6. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.
- 37 7. Pursuant to section 23.253, RSMo, of the Missouri sunset act:
- 38 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall 39 automatically sunset six years after August 28, 2005, unless reauthorized by an 40 act of the general assembly; and
- 41 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this 42 section shall automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the 43 reauthorization of this section; and
- 44 (3) This section shall terminate on December thirty-first of the calendar 45 year immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized 46 under this section is sunset.
