AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to erecting signs at state roads that intersect or cross the thirty-eighth parallel.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 227.387, to read as follows:

227.387. The state highways and transportation commission shall

- 2 erect signs commemorating the Korean War at every state road or state
- 3 highway that crosses or intersects the thirty-eighth parallel.
