### AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to providing the motoring public notice of the state's recent motor vehicle laws.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 301.163, to read as follows:

301.163. 1. Beginning January 1, 2007, the department of revenue shall, whenever an owner of a motor vehicle applies for new registration plates or renews registration plates, issue the motor vehicle owner a pamphlet summarizing any new motor vehicle laws passed by the Missouri general assembly within the last two years. The pamphlets distributed by the department of revenue or fee offices shall be written and prepared by the division of highway safety within the department of transportation. The department of revenue shall also summarize any new motor vehicle laws passed by the general assembly on the department's web site.

11 2. The director of the department of revenue shall promulgate 12 rules and regulations to implement and administer the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in 13 section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority delegated in 14 this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is 15 16 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, 17 section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly 18 pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, 19

20 or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
