AN ACT

To amend chapter 233, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to special road districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 233, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 233.525, to read as follows:

**233.525. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the
2 contrary, the boundaries of any special road district in any county of
3 the third classification without a township form of government and
4 with more than twenty-three thousand five hundred but fewer than
5 twenty-three thousand six hundred inhabitants and any county of the
6 first classification with more than thirty-seven thousand but fewer than
7 thirty-seven thousand one hundred inhabitants may be changed to
8 exclude any city of the fourth classification with more than one
9 thousand four hundred but fewer than one thousand five hundred
10 inhabitants and located in more than one county in the manner
11 prescribed in this section. A change of boundaries to exclude any city
12 of the fourth classification with more than one thousand four hundred
13 but fewer than one thousand five hundred inhabitants from the special
14 road district shall not impair or affect its organization or its rights in
15 or to property, or any of its rights or privileges; nor shall it affect or
16 impair or discharge any contract, obligation, lien, or charge for or upon
17 which it might be liable or chargeable had any change of boundaries
18 not been made. The withdrawal from any established road district
19 shall not effect the validity of the road district that remains.**

**20 2. The governing body of any city of the fourth classification
21 with more than one thousand four hundred but fewer than one**

22 thousand five hundred inhabitants and located in more than one county
23 may propose to withdraw its political boundaries from any established
24 road district and form a new road district solely within its own
25 municipal corporate limits may by resolution submit such question to
26 all the qualified voters residing within such city at a general or special
27 election called for that purpose. The ballot upon which the question of
28 withdrawing the city from any established road district shall be
29 submitted to the qualified voters residing within such city and shall
30 contain a question in substantially the following form:

31 "Shall (name of city) withdraw its political boundaries
32 from the following road districts (name of the road districts) and create
33 a new road district solely within the municipal corporate limits of
34 (name of city)?"

35 3. If the vote on the ballot issue submitted under subsection 2 of
36 this section is in the affirmative, the governing body of any city of the
37 fourth classification with more than one thousand four hundred but
38 fewer than one thousand five hundred inhabitants and located in more
39 than one county shall notify the commissioners of the respective road
40 districts that such city is no longer included in such road districts.
