AN ACT

To amend chapter 389, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prohibiting the operation of remote control locomotives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 389, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new

section, to be known as section 389.823, to read as follows: 389.823. No railroad carrier or railroad corporation shall operate

or cause to be operated on the general system of railroad tracks in this

state a remote control locomotive. As used in this section, the term

"remote control locomotive" shall mean a locomotive which, through the

use of a radio transmitter and receiver system, can be operated by a

person not physically located at the controls within the confines of the

locomotive cab.
