AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to fishing permits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new

section, to be known as section 252.252, to read as follows: 252.252. Any active member of the United States armed forces on

authorized leave, shall be exempt from paying for any fishing permit

3 issued by the department for the duration of such individual's

4 leave. Proof of such person's military status shall be required to be

carried at all times while fishing. For purposes of this section, such

proof shall consist of his or her military identification and valid

military orders showing place of assignment and leave status.
