AN ACT

To repeal section 190.550, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to emergency service fees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 190.550, RSMo, is repealed and one new section
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 190.550, to read as follows:

190.550. 1. The department of health and senior services shall by rule
2 establish a schedule of fees to be paid by applicants for specific licensure or
3 accreditation under sections 190.001 to 190.250 and sections 190.525 to 190.537;
4 except that, such fee shall not be imposed for specific licensure or accreditation
5 of:

6 (1) Persons employed by volunteer ambulance services; **or**

7 (2) **Any ambulance service, unless such service averages more**
8 **than three hundred and fifty runs per year, per five-year licensure**
9 **period. No fee shall be imposed on any new ambulance service,**
10 **applying for initial licensing, until the conclusion of the initial five-**
11 **year licensure period, whereby a yearly run average may be**
12 **ascertained based on the that period.**

13 Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo,
14 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective
15 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536,
16 RSMo, and, if applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536,
17 RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general
18 assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date,
19 or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then
20 the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August

21 28, 2005, shall be invalid and void.

22 2. All fees imposed under this section shall be collected by the department
23 and deposited in the Missouri public health services fund established in section
24 192.900, RSMo. Moneys in the fund deposited under this section shall be used
25 upon appropriation by the general assembly for the purpose of implementing the
26 provisions of sections 190.001 to 190.250 and sections 190.525 to
27 190.537. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080, RSMo, moneys
28 deposited to the credit of the fund under this section shall not revert to the credit
29 of general revenue at the end of the biennium.
