AN ACT

To repeal section 41.150, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the appointment and duties of assistant adjutants general.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 41.150, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 41.150, to read as follows:

41.150. The adjutant general may assign two assistant adjutants general
2 in the grade of brigadier general or below, one from the ground forces and the
3 other from the air forces of this state[, as well as a third assistant adjutant
4 general in the grade of major general or below from the air forces of this state,
5 who,]; **however, general officers of the line federally recognized in the
6 grade of major general may be reassigned as a state assistant adjutant
7 general without change in grade or branch. The assistant adjutant
8 generals, at the time of their appointment, shall have not less than [four] ten
9 years of [previous] military service as a commissioned officer with the military
10 forces of this state, another state or territory, the District of Columbia or the
11 United States, or in any or all such services combined, **five years of the service
12 being in field grade.** The assistant adjutants general shall **serve at the
13 pleasure of the adjutant general and** perform such duties as are assigned by
14 the adjutant general[; and during the absence of the adjutant general from the
15 state, and]. During any period when the adjutant general is unable to perform
16 such duties, the senior assistant adjutant general may, **under the direction of
17 the governor,** perform the duties of the adjutant general. [The assistant**

18 adjutants general shall serve in the grade and receive such compensation as the
19 adjutant general determines.]
