AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the Sergeant William McEntee Memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 227.386, to read as follows:

227.386. The portion of highway 21 from the intersection of Lindbergh Avenue to the intersection of Gravois Road in St. Louis County shall be designated the "Sergeant William McEntee Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs commemorating this portion of highway. Costs for such designation shall be paid for by the Kirkwood Police officers.
