AN ACT

To amend chapter 33, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the transfer of certain funds to the general revenue fund, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 33, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 33.575, to read as follows:

33.575. If in the immediate previous fiscal year, the state's net general revenue collections, as defined in section 27(a) of article IV of the Missouri constitution, less deposits made under this section, did not increase by two percent or more, the state treasurer shall deposit moneys, except for gifts, donations, or bequests, received under any state fund created by statute or any fund administratively created by 7 the office of administration, beginning January first of the current 8 fiscal year until June thirtieth of the current fiscal year into the state 9 general revenue fund. Otherwise, the state treasurer shall deposit such 10 moneys in accordance with the provisions of the section that creates each fund or into the fund administratively created by the office of 11 12 administration. The provisions of this section shall apply to all state 13 funds created by statute and all funds administratively created by the 14 office of administration, with the exception of funds created by the 15 constitution, funds for the payment of interest and principal for any 16 bonded indebtedness, funds that receive constitutionally created taxes 17 and fees, and funds created in order to receive and disburse federal 18 funds.

Section B. Because of the need to increase access to certain state revenue in light of the current fiscal crisis, section A of this act is deemed necessary for

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3 the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace and safety, and

- 4 is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution,
- 5 and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and

6 approval.
