## AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to exempting certain types of vehicles from registration and licensing laws.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 301.029, to read as follows:

301.029. 1. Any self-propelled sprayer, floater, or other form of 2 implement of husbandry that is used for spraying chemicals or 3 spreading fertilizer for agricultural purposes may be moved or 4 operated on the highways of this state without complying with the 5 provisions of this chapter relating to titling, registration and the 6 display of license plates.

2. The exemption from titling, registration, and the display of
license plates provided for in subsection 1 of this section shall apply
whether the described vehicles are laden or unladen.

3. All other requirements of the law relating to motor vehicles,
 unless the context clearly provides otherwise, shall apply to the
 vehicles described in subsection one of this section when operated on
 the highways of this state.

4. As used in this section, the term "implements of husbandry" means all self-propelled machinery manufactured to be operated at low speeds, specifically designed for, or especially adapted to be capable of, incidental over-the-road and primary offroad usage and used exclusively for the application of commercial plant food materials or agricultural chemicals.
