AN ACT

To repeal section 644.021, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to membership on the clean water commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 644.021, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 644.021, to read as follows:

644.021. 1. There is hereby created a water contaminant control agency to be known as the "Clean Water Commission of the State of Missouri", whose $\mathbf{2}$ domicile for the purposes of sections 644.006 to 644.141 shall be deemed to be 3 that of the department of natural resources. The commission shall consist of 4 seven members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the 5 senate. No more than [three] four of the members shall belong to the same 6 political party. All members shall be representative of the general interest of the 7 8 public and shall have an interest in and knowledge of conservation and the effects and control of water contaminants. Two such members, but no more than two, 9 10 shall be knowledgeable concerning the needs of agriculture, industry or mining and interested in protecting these needs in a manner consistent with the 11 12purposes of sections 644.006 to 644.141. One such member shall be knowledgeable concerning the needs of publicly owned wastewater treatment 1314 works. Four members shall represent the public. No member shall receive, or have received during the previous two years, a significant portion of his or her 1516income directly or indirectly from permit holders or applicants for a permit pursuant to any federal water pollution control act as amended and as applicable 1718to this state. All members appointed on or after August 28, 2002, shall have 19demonstrated an interest and knowledge about water quality. All members

20 appointed on or after August 28, 2002, shall be qualified by interest, education, 21 training or experience to provide, assess and evaluate scientific and technical 22 information concerning water quality, financial requirements and the effects of 23 the promulgation of standards, rules and regulations. At the first meeting of the 24 commission and at yearly intervals thereafter, the members shall select from 25 among themselves a chairman and a vice chairman.

262. The members' terms of office shall be four years and until their successors are selected and qualified. Provided, however, that the first three 27members appointed shall serve a term of two years, the next three members 2829appointed shall serve a term of four years, thereafter all members appointed shall 30serve a term of four years. There is no limitation on the number of terms any appointed member may serve. If a vacancy occurs the governor may appoint a 31member for the remaining portion of the unexpired term created by the 32vacancy. The governor may remove any appointed member for cause. The 33members of the commission shall be reimbursed for travel and other expenses 34actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties. 35

36 3. The commission shall hold at least four regular meetings each year and such additional meetings as the chairman deems desirable at a place and time to 37be fixed by the chairman. Special meetings may be called by three members of 3839 the commission upon delivery of written notice to each member of the 40commission. Reasonable written notice of all meetings shall be given by the director to all members of the commission. Four members of the commission shall 41 42constitute a quorum. All powers and duties conferred specifically upon members 43of the commission shall be exercised personally by the members and not by alternates or representatives. All actions of the commission shall be taken at 44 meetings open to the public. Any member absent from six consecutive regular 45commission meetings for any cause whatsoever shall be deemed to have resigned 46and the vacancy shall be filled immediately in accordance with subsection 1 of 47this section. 48
