AN ACT

To repeal section 116.080, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to petition circulators, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 116.080, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 116.080, to read as follows:

116.080. 1. Each petition circulator shall be at least eighteen years of

- 2 age, a citizen of the United States, a Missouri resident, a registered
- 3 voter, and registered with the secretary of state. No petition circulator shall
- 4 be paid on a per signature basis. All petition signature gathering
- 5 activities shall be subject to the general, regulatory supervision of the
- 6 secretary of state. Signatures collected by any circulator who has not
- 7 registered with the secretary of state pursuant to this chapter [on or before 5:00
- 8 p.m. on the final day for filing petitions with the secretary of state] prior to the
- 9 collection of such signatures shall not be counted.
- 10 2. Each petition circulator shall supply the following information to the
- 11 secretary of state's office:
- 12 (1) Name of petition;
- 13 (2) Name of circulator and proof of United States citizenship;
- 14 (3) Residential address, including street number, city, state and zip code,
- 15 proof of Missouri resident status and proof of current voter registration
- 16 in Missouri:
- 17 (4) Mailing address, if different;
- 18 (5) [Have you been or] Do you expect to be paid for soliciting signatures
- 19 for this petition?

- 21 (6) If the answer to subdivision (5) is yes, then identify the payor;
- 22 (7) Certification that the circulator shall not be paid on a per 23 signature basis;
- 24 (8) Signature of circulator.
- 3. The circulator information required in subsection 2 of this section shall be submitted to the secretary of state's office with the following oath and affirmation:
- 28 I HEREBY SWEAR OR AFFIRM UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT ALL STATEMENTS MADE BY ME ARE TRUE AND CORRECT. I HEREBY 29SWEAR OR AFFIRM UNDER PENALTY OF LAW THAT I AM LEGALLY 30 RESPONSIBLE FOR MY SIGNATURE GATHERING ACTIVITIES AND 31 MAY BE HELD LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR FRAUDULENT OR 32DECEPTIVE SIGNATURE GATHERING PRACTICES. I HEREBY SWEAR 33 OR AFFIRM UNDER PENALTY OF LAW THAT I WILL NOT BE PAID ON 34 A PER SIGNATURE BASIS FOR THE COLLECTION OF ANY 35 36 SIGNATURE.
- 4. Each petition circulator shall subscribe and swear to the proper affidavit on each petition page such circulator submits before a notary public commissioned in Missouri. When notarizing a circulator's signature, a notary public shall sign his or her official signature and affix his or her official seal to the affidavit only if the circulator personally appears before the notary and subscribes and swears to the affidavit in his or her presence.
- 5. Any circulator who falsely swears to a circulator's affidavit knowing it to be false or receives payment for collecting signatures on a per signature basis is guilty of a class A misdemeanor punishable, notwithstanding the provisions of section 560.021, RSMo, to the contrary, for a term of imprisonment not to exceed one year in the county jail or a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars or both.

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
