

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

WHEREAS, voting is a fundamental part of a democracy; and

WHEREAS, facilitating the dissemination of information and education on the voting process to Missouri citizens promotes a healthy democracy; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Conservation's hunting and fishing licensing program serves as an established point of contact between many citizens and state government:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Missouri Senate, Ninety-Fourth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the House of Representatives concurring therein,

hereby encourage the Conservation Commission to develop a partnership with the Secretary of State's office to implement a streamlined process for electronically transmitting the contact information for individuals who apply for a hunting or fishing license who are not registered to vote. Upon receipt of the information, the Secretary of State is encouraged to send voter registration information to such individuals; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Missouri Senate be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the Conservation Commission and the Secretary of State.
