## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article VIII of the  
Constitution of Missouri relating to voter identification.

*Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on  
2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2008, or at a special  
3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted  
4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following  
5 amendment to article VIII of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article VIII, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding  
2 thereto one new section, to be known as section 8, to read as follows:

**Section 8. Any person seeking to vote in a public election shall**  
2 **establish their qualification as a citizen of the state of Missouri**  
3 **lawfully present in the United States of America by providing election**  
4 **officials a form of identification, including valid government-issued**  
5 **photo identification, as established by general law. The state shall**  
6 **provide at least one form of such identification required to vote at no**  
7 **cost to any otherwise qualified citizen who does not already possess**  
8 **such identification and who desires the identification in order to vote.**  
9 **In the event that any political subdivision incurs costs to implement**  
10 **the requirements of this law, the state shall reimburse the political**  
11 **subdivision for such costs.**
