### AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to memorial highway designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 227.364 and 227.366, to read as follows:

227.364. The portion of Missouri Route 74/34 contained in Cape

- 2 Girardeau County, from the Missouri/Illinois state line west to the
- 3 intersection of Business Loop 55/U.S. 61/Missouri Route 34, shall be
- 4 designated as the "John Oliver Jr. Parkway". The provisions of section
- 5 227.299 regarding highway designations shall not be applicable to the
- 6 provisions of this section.

227.366. Notwithstanding subsection 8 of section 227.299, the

- 2 portion of U.S. Highway 60 contained in Stoddard County, from where
- 3 U.S. Highway 60 and Route ZZ intersect to where U.S. Highway 60 and
- 4 Missouri Route 25 intersect, shall be designated the "Sergeant Carl
- 5 Dewayne Graham Jr. Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation
- 6 shall be paid by the Missouri Troopers' Association.
