**AN ACT**

To repeal section 301.301, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to stolen license plate tabs, with an emergency clause.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 301.301, RSMo, is repealed and one new section  
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 301.301, to read as follows:

301.301. 1. Any person replacing a stolen license plate tab **issued on or**  
2 **after January 1, 2009**, may receive at no cost up to two sets of two license plate  
3 tabs per year when the application for the replacement tab is accompanied with  
4 a police report that is corresponding with the stolen license plate tab.

5 2. Any person replacing a stolen license plate tab **issued prior to**  
6 **January 1, 2009**, may receive at no cost up to two sets of two license  
7 **plate tabs per year when the application for the replacement tab is**  
8 **accompanied with a notarized affidavit verifying that such license plate**  
9 **tab or tabs were stolen.**

Section B. Because of the need to provide Missouri motorists with a  
2 method to replace stolen license plate tabs without administrative red tape and  
3 because of the need to verify the payment of registration fees, the provisions of  
4 section A of this act are deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
5 public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and are hereby declared to be an  
6 emergency within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall  
7 be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
