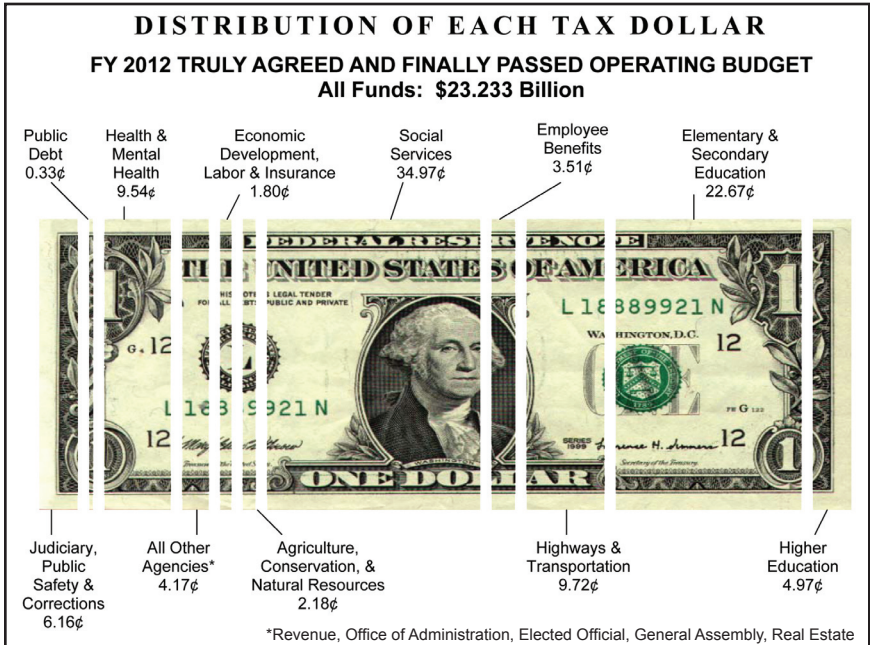

What is identity theft?

Identity theft occurs when someone uses your personal information to commit fraud or other crimes. The thief takes your Social Security number, bank account number or other information and causes problems, like taking out loans in your name, charging money to your credit card, or taking money out of your bank account.



How do I prevent identity theft?

- Don't give out your Social Security or account numbers unless you initiate the contact. Don't carry your Social Security card.
- Leave your Social Security number off checks and driver's license.
- Shred trash with sensitive information. Include convenience checks and credit-card offers you get in the mail.
- Send sensitive mail using a Post Office drop box, rather than your mailbox at home.
- Carry only the credit cards and documents you need on a daily basis.
