REDISTRICTING IN MISSOURI

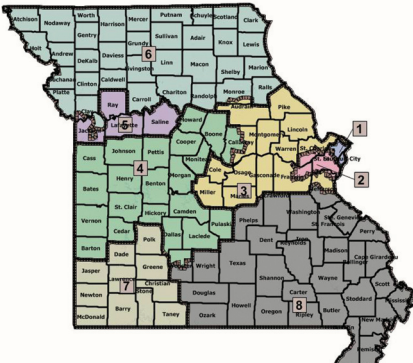
In a historic vote, the Legislature successfully overrode the governor's veto regarding the new congressional map (**HB 193**), which was drafted to reconfigure Missouri's congressional districts to reflect the results of the 2010 Census. The new map reduces Missouri's number of congressional seats from nine to eight.

As required by the state constitution, a two-thirds majority

vote is required to override a veto. The House vote was 109-44 and Senate vote was 28-6, fulfilling the constitutional requirement.

A vote to overturn a veto is a rare occurrence — the last time the Legislature successfully overrode a governor's veto during regular session was in 1980 — so I am very grateful that my colleagues and I were able to pull together to put the congressional map into action.

As chair of the Senate Select Committee on Redistricting, I can tell you that assembling Missouri's new congressional districts was a challenge, but the hard work has definitely paid off, as now citizens have congressional districts that fairly represent them.



BENEFICIAL MEASURES PASSED BY THE LEGISLATURE...

MY PASSED LEGISLATION

One of the measures sent to the governor for his signature is one of my own bills, **SB 132**. This measure addresses fraudulent motor vehicle contracts and warranties, as well as vehicle licensing, the “free look” period, deceptive practices, the suspension and revocation of licenses, and the registry of motor vehicles. If signed by the governor, my bill would go into effect on Aug. 28, 2011.

MEASURES I HANDLED IN THE MISSOURI SENATE

Several bills I handled in the Senate have been sent to the governor. Some of those measures include:

- **HB 354**, which will exempt electric vehicles from Missouri’s motor vehicle emissions

inspection program. This bill has been signed by the governor.

- **HB 470**, which would stop churches from getting taxed if they had an entertainer perform at their congregation.
- **HB 604**, which would not allow a child to be taken from his or her parents, just because both parents are disabled.
- **HB 648**, which would change the laws regarding individuals with disabilities. The bill would change all references of “mentally retarded,” “mental retardation,” or “handicapped” in current state law to “intellectually disabled,” “intellectual disability,” or “disabled,” respectively. The bill would also protect the rights of parents with disabilities (similar to the provision found in **HB 604**).

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

On June 17, the governor vetoed **SB 3**, a measure that would have established requirements for voting and voter photo identification for elections. This measure was the simplest way to help prevent voter fraud in Missouri, and I am disappointed that the governor vetoed the bill. I will continue to fight to keep one of our greatest liberties protected.

PROTECTING OUR CHILDREN

Senate Bill 54 would protect our children from sexual predators in Missouri schools. The legislation, also known as the “Amy Hestir Student Protection Act,” was named for a young woman who was continually assaulted throughout her school years.

CONCEALED WEAPONS

House Bill 294 would protect our Second Amendment rights, and lower the age for a concealed carry permit from 23 to 21 years of age. The Second Amendment states, “A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.”

DRUG TESTING FOR TANF RECIPIENTS

House Bill 73 would require certain applicants for and recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program benefits to be tested for illegal drug use. This bill would ensure that taxpayer dollars don’t go toward illegal activity, and would promote a drug-free life for Missouri families.

PROTECTING LIFE IN MISSOURI

To protect the life of the unborn in Missouri, **SB 65** and **HB 161** have been passed by the

Legislature. These measures would prevent late-term abortions and protect viable babies of 20 weeks or more. If the unborn child is 20 weeks or more, not determined viable, and an abortion is performed, the bill requires the doctor to submit a report to the Department of Health and Senior Services.

FRANCHISE TAX

Senate Bill 19 will first freeze and then gradually phase out Missouri’s corporate franchise tax over a five-year period. This will allow companies to feel confident about investing in Missouri. This legislation has been signed by the governor.

MO Rx PROGRAM

House Bill 412 will continue the Missouri Rx program, which helps pay the prescription drug costs of low-income seniors and disabled citizens covered by Medicare. This bill has been signed by the governor.



Legislation needs to be passed that will make Missouri an even better place to live.

MISSOURI'S BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012

On May 5th, my colleagues and I passed a balanced budget for Missouri. The \$23.2 billion operating budget is for the 2012 fiscal year that starts on July 1, 2011. Missouri is still considered one of the top five most financially sound states in the country, due to our commitment of fiscal responsibility.

As vice chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee, I can tell you that getting the budget passed was not an easy task, considering the cuts and compromises that had to be made, but I am confident that a fair and balanced budget was passed for the people of Missouri.

One of our top priorities when drafting the budget was our children's education. Our kids are our future, and they deserve the best teachers, facilities, and tools possible to succeed. Lawmakers approved a \$10 million increase for K-12 transportation (compared to the governor's recommended plan), as well as a \$12 million increase for higher education over the governor's budget recommendation.

We also approved an \$8 million increase for in-home care providers, and agreed that the Missouri Rx program should receive full funding at \$19.6 million.
