## AN ACT

To amend chapter 192, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the inspection of certain x-ray systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 192, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 192.500, to read as follows:

192.500. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall

- 2 mean:
- 3 (1) "Cone beam computed tomography system", a medical imaging
- 4 device using x-ray computed tomography to capture data using a cone-
- 5 shaped x-ray beam, which has radiation intensity no greater than thirty
- 6 milligrays;
- 7 (2) "Panoramic x-ray system", an imaging device that captures
- 8 the entire mouth in a single, two-dimensional image including the
- 9 teeth, upper and lower jaws, and surrounding structures and tissues.
- 2. Cone beam computed tomography systems and panoramic x-
- 11 ray systems shall not be required to be inspected more frequently than
- 12 every four years.
- 13 3. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, inspections of x-ray
- 14 equipment used exclusively on animals by a licensed veterinarian or
- 15 veterinary facility under chapter 340 shall not be required to be
- 16 inspected more frequently than every four years.
- 4. The provisions of this section shall expire on December 31,
- 18 **2025**.
