

#### MEDICARE/SOCIAL SECURITY

#### **MEDICAID**

Medicaid is a health assistance program administered by the state according to certain federal guidelines. Benefits are available to persons who are temporarily or permanently disabled, as well as low-income families and others.

Medicaid pays for visits to the doctor; immunization against diseases such as measles, tetanus and polio; ambulance services in case of emergency; in-patient hospital care; yearly eye examinations; children's glasses; laboratory and X-ray services; home health care services; family planning services; certain dental work and certain prescriptions and nursing home care for eligible recipients.

#### You May Be Eligible If You Are:

- A resident of the State of Missouri; and
- 65 years of age or older and enrolled in Medicare; or age 18 − 64, disabled and enrolled in Medicare; and
- Single with an annual gross income of \$19,600 or less; or married with an annual gross income of \$26,400 or less; and
- Enrolled in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan (Part D). To learn more about the Part D or to choose and enroll in a Part D plan that's best for you, call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) toll-free.

**Prescription Drug Information Assistance (CLAIM)**...1-800-390-3330 CLAIM assists persons needing prescription drugs to locate appropriate sources for medicines.

Veterans can call to see if they are eligible for prescription drug benefits.

Seniors can ask their physician for free samples. If seniors are not eligible under the Missouri Rx program, they can ask their physician for a 90-day supply that provides a savings.

#### NOTICE REQUIRED ON UTILITY CUTOFFS

During the winter heating season, Missouri gas and electric utilities regulated by the Missouri Public Service Commission must give customers at least 10 days written notice before service may be disconnected and additional written or personal contact at least 96 hours prior to disconnection. Additionally, no disconnections may occur on any day in which the temperature is forecast to be below 30 degrees.

These rules, which are in effect between Nov. 1 and March 31, require also that customers whose service is about to be cut off be told that they might qualify for financial aid to help pay their utility bills. Elderly or handicapped customers who register with utilities in advance are given even greater protection by the new rules.
