AN ACT

To amend chapter 10, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to state designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 10, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 10.105 and 10.200, to read as follows:

10.105. The pawpaw tree (asimina triloba) is designated as the state fruit tree of Missouri.

10.200. The Cryptobranchus alleganiensis, also known as the

- 3 shall be known as the official endangered species for the state of
