Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 1, Page 3, Section 84.344, Line 10-19,

2 of said page, by striking said lines and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:

4 "6. (1) Commencing August 31, 2020, commissioned and
5 civilian personnel who ~~[were previously]~~ are employed by the
6 ~~[board shall continue to]~~ municipal police force established
7 under this section shall not be subject, throughout their
8 employment for the city not within a county, to a residency ~~[rule~~
9 no more restrictive than a] requirement of retaining a primary
10 residence in a city not within a county ~~[for a total of seven~~
11 years and of then allowing them to maintain a] so long as the
12 primary residence ~~[outside the city not within a county so long~~
13 as the residence] is located within a one-hour response time.
14 The provisions of this subdivision shall expire on August 31,
15 2021.

16 (2) Only commissioned and civilian personnel who are hired
17 after August 31, 2021, by the municipal police force established
18 under this section may be subject, throughout their employment
19 for a city not within a county, to a residency rule no more
20 restrictive than a requirement of retaining a residence in a city
21 not within a county for a total of seven years and of then

1 allowing them to maintain a primary residence outside the city
2 not within a county so long as the primary residence is located
3 within a one-hour response time."; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 16, Section 285.040, Line 3 of
5 said page, by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "3. Public safety employees who are hired after August 31,
7 2021, by a city not within a county throughout their employment
8 for the city not within a county, may be subject to a residence
9 rule no more restrictive than a requirement of retaining a
10 residence in a city not within a county for a total a seven years
11 and of then allowing them to maintain a primary residence outside
12 the city not within a county so long as the primary residence is
13 located within a one-hour response time.".
