4	Further amend said bill, page 18, section 313.004, line 19
5	of said page, by inserting immediately after said line the
6	following:
7	"313.230. The commission shall:
8	(1) Issue rules and regulations concerning the operation of
9	the Missouri state lottery. The rules and regulations shall
10	include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
11	(a) The type of lottery to be conducted, [except no lottery
12	may use any coin- or token-operated amusement device and no
13	lottery game shall be based in any form on the outcome of
14	sporting events. However, it shall be legal to] <u>including the</u>
15	use <u>of</u> clerk- or player-activated terminals, which are coin- or
16	currency-operated, lottery games based on the outcome of a
17	sporting event, and to dispense lottery tickets. Lottery games
18	based on the outcome of a sporting event shall be limited to
19	"parlay games", which term shall mean a game in which two or more
20	teams are involved in determining the winning outcome of the
21	game;
22	(b) The price, or prices, of tickets or shares in the
23	lottery;

(c) The numbers and sizes of the prizes on the winning
 tickets or shares;

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(d) The manner of selecting the winning tickets or shares;

4 (e) The manner of payment of prizes to the holders of
5 winning tickets or shares;

6 (f) The frequency of the drawings or selections of winning
7 tickets or shares, without limitation;

8 (g) The types or numbers of locations at which tickets or 9 shares may be sold and the method to be used in selling tickets 10 or shares;

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(h) The method to be used in selling tickets or shares;

12 (i) The licensing of lottery game retailers to sell tickets13 or shares;

(j) The manner and amount of compensation, including commissions, ticket discounts, incentives and any other remuneration, to be paid to or retained by lottery game retailers;

18 (k) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing from 19 the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other sources 20 among:

a. The payment of prizes to the holders of winning tickets
 or shares;

b. The payment of costs incurred in the operation and
administration of the lottery, including the expenses of the
commission and the costs resulting from any contract or contracts
entered into for promotional, advertising or operational services
or for the purchase or lease of lottery equipment and materials;

c. For the repayment to the general revenue fund of any
amount appropriated for initial start-up of the lottery; and

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d. For timely transfer to the state lottery fund as
 provided by law;

(1) Such other matters necessary or desirable for the
efficient and economical operation and administration of the
lottery and for the convenience of the purchasers of tickets or
shares and the holders of winning tickets or shares. The
commission may disburse money for payment of lottery prizes;

8 (2) Amend, repeal, or supplement any such rules and
9 regulations from time to time as it deems necessary or desirable;

(3) Advise and make recommendations to the director
 regarding the operation and administration of the lottery;

Report quarterly to the governor and the general 12 (4) 13 assembly the total lottery revenues, prize disbursements and 14 other expenses for the preceding quarter, and to make an annual 15 report, which shall include a full and complete statement of 16 lottery revenues, prize disbursements and other expenses, to the 17 governor and the general assembly, and including such 18 recommendations for changes in sections 313.200 to 313.350 as it 19 deems necessary or desirable;

(5) Report to the governor and general assembly any matters which shall require immediate changes in the laws of this state in order to prevent abuses and evasions of sections 313.200 to 313.350 or rules and regulations promulgated thereunder or to rectify undesirable conditions in connection with the administration or operation of the lottery;

(6) Carry on a continuous study and investigation of the
lottery throughout the state and to make a continuous study and
investigation of the operation and the administration of similar
laws which may be in effect in other states or countries, any

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1 literature on the subject which from time to time may be 2 published or available, any federal laws which may affect the 3 operation of the lottery, and the reaction of Missouri citizens 4 to existing and potential features of the lottery with a view to 5 recommending or effecting changes that will tend to serve the 6 purposes of sections 313.200 to 313.350;

7 (7) Ensure that all employees of the state lottery
8 commission hired after July 12, 1990, shall not be related to any
9 member of the state lottery commission or any employee of the
10 state lottery commission within the third degree of consanguinity
11 or affinity."; and

Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.

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
