Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 718, Page 2, Section 27.115, Line 14,

- 2 of said page, by inserting after all of said line the following:
- 3 "36.020. Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the
- 4 following terms mean:
- 5 (1) "Agency", "state agency" or "agency of the state", each
- 6 department, board, commission or office of the state except for
- 7 offices of the elected officials, the general assembly, the
- 8 judiciary and academic institutions;
- 9 (2) "Appointing authority", an officer or agency subject to
- 10 this chapter having power to make appointments;
- 11 (3) "Board", the personnel advisory board as established by
- 12 section 36.050;
- 13 (4) "Broad classification band", a grouping of positions
- 14 with similar levels of responsibility or expertise;
- 15 (5) "Class", "class of positions", or "job class", a group
- 16 of positions subject to this chapter sufficiently alike in
- 17 duties, authority and responsibilities to justify the same
- 18 qualifications and the same schedule of pay to all positions in
- 19 the group;
- 20 (6) "Director", the director of the division of personnel
- 21 of the office of administration;

1           (7) "Disabled veteran", a veteran who has served on active  
2 duty in the Armed Forces at any time who receives compensation as  
3 a result of a service-connected disability claim allowed by the  
4 federal agency responsible for the administration of veteran's  
5 affairs, or who receives disability retirement or disability  
6 pension benefits from a federal agency as a result of such a  
7 disability or a National Guard veteran who was permanently  
8 disabled as a result of active service to the state at the call  
9 of the governor;

10           (8) "Division of service" or "division", a state department  
11 or any division or branch of the state, or any agency of the  
12 state government, all the positions and employees in which are  
13 under the same appointing authority;

14           (9) "Eleemosynary or penal institutions", an institution  
15 within state government holding, housing, or caring for inmates,  
16 patients, veterans, juveniles, or other individuals entrusted to  
17 or assigned to the state where it is anticipated that such  
18 individuals will be in residence for longer than one day.  
19 Eleemosynary or penal institutions shall not include elementary,  
20 secondary, or higher education institutions operated separately  
21 or independently from the foregoing institutions;

22           (10) "Eligible", a person whose name is on a register or  
23 who has been determined to meet the qualifications for a class or  
24 position;

25           (11) "Employee", shall include only those persons employed  
26 in excess of thirty-two hours per calendar week, for a duration  
27 that could exceed six months, by a state agency and shall not  
28 include patients, inmates, or residents in state eleemosynary or  
29 penal institutions who work for the state agency operating an

1 eleemosynary or penal institutions;

2 (12) "Examination" or "competitive examination", a means of  
3 determining eligibility or fitness for a class or position;

4 (13) "Open competitive examination", a selection process  
5 for positions in a particular class, admission to which is not  
6 limited to persons employed in positions subject to this chapter  
7 pursuant to subsection 1 of section 36.030;

8 (14) "Promotional examination", a selection process for  
9 positions in a particular class, admission to which is limited to  
10 employees with regular status in positions subject to this  
11 chapter pursuant to subsection 1 of section 36.030;

12 (15) "Register of eligibles", a list, which may be  
13 restricted by locality, of persons who have been found qualified  
14 for appointment to a position subject to this chapter pursuant to  
15 subsection 1 of section 36.030;

16 (16) "Regular employee", a person employed in a position  
17 described under subdivision (2) of subsection 1 of section 36.030  
18 who has successfully completed a probationary period as provided  
19 in section 36.250;

20 (17) "State equal employment opportunity officer", the  
21 individual designated by the governor or the commissioner of  
22 administration as having responsibility for monitoring the  
23 compliance of the state as an employer with applicable equal  
24 employment opportunity law and regulation and for leadership in  
25 efforts to establish a state workforce which reflects the  
26 diversity of Missouri citizens at all levels of employment;

27 (18) "Surviving spouse", the unmarried surviving spouse of  
28 a deceased disabled veteran or the unmarried [survivor's]  
29 surviving spouse of any person who was killed while on active

1 duty in the Armed Forces of the United States or an unmarried  
2 surviving spouse of a National Guard veteran who was killed as a  
3 result of active service to the state at the call of the  
4 governor;

5 (19) "Veteran", any person who is a citizen of this state  
6 who has been separated under honorable conditions from the Armed  
7 Forces of the United States who served on active duty during  
8 peacetime or wartime for at least six consecutive months, unless  
9 released early as a result of a service-connected disability or a  
10 reduction in force at the convenience of the government, or any  
11 member of a reserve or National Guard component who has  
12 satisfactorily completed at least six years of service or who was  
13 called or ordered to active duty by the President and  
14 participated in any campaign or expedition for which a campaign  
15 badge or service medal has been authorized."; and

16 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
