## AN ACT

To amend chapter 196, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to opioid addiction treatment.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 196, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new  
2 section, to be known as section 196.1050, to read as follows:

**196.1050. 1. The proceeds of any monetary settlement or portion  
2 of a global settlement between the attorney general of the state and any  
3 drug manufacturers, distributors, or combination thereof to resolve an  
4 opioid-related cause of action against such drug manufacturers,  
5 distributors, or combination thereof in a state or federal court shall  
6 only be utilized to pay for opioid addiction treatment and services and  
7 health care and law enforcement costs related to opioid addiction  
8 treatment. Under no circumstances shall such settlement moneys be  
9 utilized to fund other services, programs, or expenses not reasonably  
10 related to opioid addiction treatment.**

11 **2. (1) There is hereby established in the state treasury the  
12 "Opioid Addiction Treatment and Recovery Fund", which shall consist  
13 of the proceeds of any settlement described in subsection 1 of this  
14 section, as well as any funds appropriated by the general assembly, or  
15 gifts, grants, donations, or bequests. The state treasurer shall be  
16 custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180,  
17 the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a  
18 dedicated fund and money in the fund shall be used by the department  
19 of mental health and the department of public safety for the purposes  
20 set forth in subsection 1 of this section.**

21           **(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the**  
22 **contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium**  
23 **shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.**

24           **(3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the**  
25 **same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys**  
26 **earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.**
