AN ACT

To repeal section 143.011, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 143.011, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections

- 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 143.011 and 414.162, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 143.011. 1. A tax is hereby imposed for every taxable year on the
- 2 Missouri taxable income of every resident. The tax shall be determined by
- 3 applying the tax table or the rate provided in section 143.021, which is based
- 4 upon the following rates:

5	If the Missouri taxable income is:	The tax is:
6	Not over \$1,000.00	1 1/2% of the Missouri taxable income
7	Over \$1,000 but not over \$2,000	15 plus 2% of excess over $1,000$
8	Over \$2,000 but not over \$3,000	35 plus 2 $1/2%$ of excess over $2,000$
9	Over \$3,000 but not over \$4,000	\$60 plus 3% of excess over \$3,000

- 10 Over \$4,000 but not over \$5,000 \$90 plus 3 1/2% of excess over \$4,000
- 11 Over \$5,000 but not over \$6,000 \$125 plus 4% of excess over \$5,000
- 12 Over \$6,000 but not over \$7,000 \$165 plus 4 1/2% of excess over \$6,000
- 13 Over \$7,000 but not over \$8,000 \$210 plus 5% of excess over \$7,000
- 14 Over \$8,000 but not over \$9,000 \$260 plus 5 1/2% of excess over \$8,000
- 15 Over \$9,000 \$315 plus 6% of excess over \$9,000
- 16 2. (1) Beginning with the 2017 calendar year, the top rate of tax under
- 17 subsection 1 of this section may be reduced over a period of years. Each
- 18 reduction in the top rate of tax shall be by one-tenth of a percent and no more

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- than one reduction shall occur in a calendar year. No more than five reductions 19
- shall be made under this subsection. Reductions in the rate of tax shall take 20
- effect on January first of a calendar year and such reduced rates shall continue 21
- 22 in effect until the next reduction occurs.

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- 23 (2) A reduction in the rate of tax shall only occur if the amount of net general revenue collected in the previous fiscal year exceeds the highest amount 2425 of net general revenue collected in any of the three fiscal years prior to such fiscal year by at least one hundred fifty million dollars. 26
- 27 (3) Any modification of tax rates under this subsection shall only apply 28 to tax years that begin on or after a modification takes effect.
- 29 (4) The director of the department of revenue shall, by rule, adjust the tax 30 tables under subsection 1 of this section to effectuate the provisions of this 31 subsection. The bracket for income subject to the top rate of tax shall be 32eliminated once the top rate of tax has been reduced to five and one-half percent, 33 and the top remaining rate of tax shall apply to all income in excess of the income 34 in the second highest remaining income bracket.
- 35 3. (1) In addition to the rate reductions under subsection 2 of this section, beginning with the 2019 calendar year, the top rate of tax under subsection 1 of 36 37 this section shall be reduced by four-tenths of one percent. Such reduction in the rate of tax shall take effect on January first of the 2019 calendar year. 38
 - (2) The modification of tax rates under this subsection shall only apply to tax years that begin on or after the date the modification takes effect.
- (3) The director of the department of revenue shall, by rule, adjust the tax 41 42 tables under subsection 1 of this section to effectuate the provisions of this 43 subsection.
 - 4. (1) In addition to the rate reductions under subsections 2 and 3 of this section, beginning with 2021 calendar year, the top rate of tax under subsection 1 of this section shall be reduced by three-tenths of one percent. Such reduction in the rate of tax shall take effect on January first of a calendar year.
 - (2) The modification of tax rates under this subsection shall only apply to tax years that begin on or after the date the modification takes effect.
- 52 (3) The director of the department of revenue shall, by rule, adjust the tax tables under subsection 1 of this section to effectuate the provisions of this subsection.

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- 55 5. Beginning with the 2017 calendar year, the brackets of Missouri taxable income identified in subsection 1 of this section shall be adjusted annually by the percent increase in inflation. The director shall publish such brackets annually beginning on or after October 1, 2016. Modifications to the brackets shall take effect on January first of each calendar year and shall apply to tax years beginning on or after the effective date of the new brackets.
 - [5.] **6.** As used in this section, the following terms mean:
- 62 (1) "CPI", the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for the 63 United States as reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, or its successor 64 index;
- 65 (2) "CPI for the preceding calendar year", the average of the CPI as of the 66 close of the twelve month period ending on August thirty-first of such calendar 67 year;
- (3) "Net general revenue collected", all revenue deposited into the general revenue fund, less refunds and revenues originally deposited into the general revenue fund but designated by law for a specific distribution or transfer to another state fund;
- 72 (4) "Percent increase in inflation", the percentage, if any, by which the 73 CPI for the preceding calendar year exceeds the CPI for the year beginning 74 September 1, 2014, and ending August 31, 2015.
- 414.162. 1. Beginning January 1, 2021, the department of agriculture shall impose a surcharge on all petroleum products within this state which are enumerated by section 414.032. Such surcharge shall be administered pursuant to the provisions of section 414.102 and subsections 1 and 2 of section 414.152. Such surcharge shall be imposed upon such petroleum products within this state and shall be imposed at the following rate:
- 8 (1) For the year beginning January 1, 2021, and ending December 9 31, 2021, such surcharge shall be two hundred ten dollars per eight thousand gallons;
- 12 (2) For the year beginning January 1, 2022, and ending December 12 31, 2022, such surcharge shall be three hundred dollars per eight 13 thousand gallons;
- 14 (3) For the year beginning January 1, 2023, and ending December 15 31, 2023, such surcharge shall be three hundred ninety dollars per eight 16 thousand gallons; and

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- 17 (4) For all years beginning on or after January 1, 2024, such
- 18 surcharge shall be four hundred eighty dollars per eight thousand
- 19 gallons.
- 20 All revenue generated by the assessment of such surcharges shall be
- 21 deposited in the state road fund created pursuant to Section 30(b) of
- 22 Article IV of the Missouri Constitution.
- 23 2. Railroad corporations as defined in section 388.010 and airline
- 24 companies as defined in section 155.010 shall not be subject to the
- 25 surcharge described in this section.
