Amend SCS/Senate Bill No. 5, Page 4, Section 68.075, Line 87,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "91.450. Any city of the third or fourth class, and  
 4 any town or village, and any city now organized or which may  
 5 hereafter be organized and having a special charter, and  
 6 which now has or may hereafter have less than thirty  
 7 thousand inhabitants, shall have power to erect or to  
 8 acquire, by purchase or otherwise, maintain and operate,  
 9 waterworks, gas works, electric light and power plant, steam  
 10 heating plant, or any other device or plant for furnishing  
 11 light, power or heat, telephone plant or exchange, street  
 12 railway or any other public transportation, conduit system,  
 13 public auditorium or convention hall, which are hereby  
 14 declared public utilities, and such cities, towns or  
 15 villages are hereby authorized and empowered to provide for  
 16 the erection or extension of the same by the issue of bonds  
 17 therefor, and any city, town or village which may own,  
 18 maintain or operate, and which may hereafter acquire, by  
 19 purchase or otherwise, and operate, or which may engage in  
 20 the construction of any of the plants, systems or works  
 21 mentioned in this section, is hereby authorized and  
 22 empowered to establish, by ordinance, within such city, town  
 23 or village, an executive department to be known as "The  
 24 Board of Public Works", to consist of four persons, electors  
 25 of said city, town or village, who have resided therein for  
 26 a period of two years next before their appointment, or, for

27 any county of the third classification, any resident of the  
28 county that receives services from such board, who shall be  
29 appointed by the mayor of such city, town or village, and  
30 confirmed by the common council in such manner as other  
31 appointive officers of such city, town or village are  
32 appointed and confirmed. The members of such board shall  
33 hold office for a term of four years each, or until their  
34 successors are appointed and qualified; provided, that the  
35 members of said board shall hold office for a term of four  
36 years each, except the first incumbents, as members of said  
37 board of public works, who shall be appointed and hold  
38 office for the term of one, two, three and four years  
39 respectively."; and

40 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
