Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 271, Page 7, Section 59.100, Line 15,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following;

3 "82.390. 1. Beginning January 1, 1998, the license  
 4 collector of the City of St. Louis shall receive a salary of  
 5 fifty-eight thousand three hundred dollars per year and  
 6 beginning January 1, 1999, the license collector of the City  
 7 of St. Louis shall receive a salary of sixty-four thousand  
 8 one hundred thirty dollars, payable as provided in section  
 9 82.395. Beginning [January 1, 2000, the compensation of the  
 10 license collector of the City of St. Louis] January 1, 2022,  
 11 the license collector of the city of St. Louis shall receive  
 12 a salary of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars per  
 13 year and such salary may be annually increased by an amount  
 14 equal to the annual salary adjustment for employees of the  
 15 City of St. Louis as approved by the board of aldermen of  
 16 such city.

17 2. The license collector may appoint one chief deputy,  
 18 and one assistant deputy license collector, either of whom,  
 19 in the absence for any cause of the license collector, may  
 20 perform all the duties of the license collector. The  
 21 license collector may appoint a cashier, an assistant  
 22 cashier, a secretary and such other clerks, account clerks  
 23 and inspectors as are required by the license collector to  
 24 properly and efficiently perform the duties of the license  
 25 collector's office when such positions are approved by the  
 26 board of aldermen of such city.

27           3. The salaries and compensation of the employees  
28 enumerated in subsection 2 of this section shall be payable  
29 as provided in section 82.395.

30           4. The license collector, deputy license collector and  
31 clerks may administer oaths in the transaction of the  
32 business of the office. The license collector and the  
33 license collector's sureties are responsible for the  
34 official acts of all employees appointed by the license  
35 collector."; and

36           Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
