Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 283, Page 35, Section 311.482, Line 37,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "311.620. 1. No person shall be appointed as agent,  
 4 assistant, deputy or inspector under the provisions of the  
 5 liquor control law who shall have been convicted of or  
 6 against whom any indictment may be pending for any offense;  
 7 nor shall any person be appointed as such agent, assistant,  
 8 deputy or inspector who is not of good character or who is  
 9 not a citizen of the United States, and who is not [or has  
 10 not been] a resident taxpaying citizen of the state [for a  
 11 period of three years previous to his] at the time of his or  
 12 her appointment; or who is not able to read and write the  
 13 English language or who does not possess ordinary physical  
 14 strength and who is not able to pass such physical and  
 15 mental examination as the [majority of a board, consisting  
 16 of the governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, and  
 17 the] supervisor of [liquor] alcohol and tobacco control may  
 18 prescribe.

19 2. No agent, assistant, deputy or inspector so  
 20 appointed shall hold any other commission or office,  
 21 elective or appointive or accept any other employment  
 22 compensation while he or she is an employee of the  
 23 [department of liquor] division of alcohol and tobacco  
 24 control, except with the written permission of the  
 25 supervisor of [liquor] alcohol and tobacco control. No  
 26 agent, assistant, deputy or inspector of the [department of

27 liquor] division of alcohol and tobacco control shall accept  
28 any reward or gift other than his or her regular salary and  
29 expenses as provided in this chapter. No agent, assistant,  
30 deputy or inspector of the [department of liquor] division  
31 of alcohol and tobacco control shall perform any police duty  
32 connected with the conduct of any election, nor at any time  
33 or in any manner electioneer for or against any party  
34 ticket, or any candidate for nomination or office on any  
35 party ticket, nor for or against any proposition of any kind  
36 or nature to be voted upon at any election.

37 3. The agents, assistants, deputies and inspectors  
38 appointed under the provisions of section 311.610 shall  
39 before entering upon the discharge of their duties, each  
40 take and subscribe an oath to support the Constitution and  
41 laws of the United States and the State of Missouri and to  
42 faithfully demean themselves in office in the form  
43 prescribed by Section 11, Article VII of the Constitution of  
44 this State, and they shall each give bond to be approved by  
45 the supervisor of [liquor] alcohol and tobacco control for  
46 faithful performance of the duties of their respective  
47 offices and to safely keep and account for all moneys and  
48 property received by them. This bond shall be in the sum of  
49 five thousand dollars, and the cost of furnishing all such  
50 bonds shall be paid by the state.

51 4. Any agent, assistant, deputy or inspector of the  
52 [department of liquor] division of alcohol and tobacco  
53 control who shall violate the provisions of this chapter  
54 shall be immediately discharged."; and
