Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 212, Page 8, Section 217.030, Line 13,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "217.243. 1. Effective January 1, 2023, any inmate
 4 who receives an on-site nonemergency medical examination or
 5 treatment from the correctional center's medical personnel
 6 shall be assessed a co-pay fee of fifty cents per visit for
 7 the medical examination or treatment.

8 2. Inmates shall not be charged a co-pay fee for the
 9 following:

- 10 (1) Staff-approved follow-up treatment for chronic
 11 illnesses;
 12 (2) Preventive health care;
 13 (3) Emergency services;
 14 (4) Prenatal care;
 15 (5) Diagnosis or treatment of infectious diseases;
 16 (6) Mental health care; or
 17 (7) Substance abuse treatment.

18 3. Inmates without funds shall not be charged,
 19 provided they are considered to be indigent and are unable
 20 to pay the co-pay fee.

21 4. The department shall deposit all funds collected
 22 pursuant to this section in the general revenue fund of the
 23 state."; and

24 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
