2	by inserting after all of said line the following:		
3	"12. No institution or training provider shall be		
4	considered to have an eligible undergraduate program of		
5	study if said institution or training provider teaches		
6	divisive concepts, as such term is defined in section		
7	173.2556. For the purposes of the provisions of this		
8	subsection, "divisive concepts" shall mean concepts that:		
9	(1) One race or sex is inherently superior to another		
10	race or sex;		
11	(2) The United States is fundamentally racist or		
12	2 <u>sexist;</u>		
13	(3) An individual, by virtue of his or her race or		
14	sex, is inherently racist, sexist, or oppressive, whether		
15	consciously or unconsciously;		
16	(4) An individual should be discriminated against or		
17	receive adverse treatment solely or partly because of his or		
18	her race or sex;		
19	(5) Members of one race or sex cannot avoid treating		
20	others differently with respect to race or sex;		
21	(6) An individual's moral character is necessarily		
22	determined by his or her race or sex;		
23	(7) An individual, by virtue of his or her race or		
24	sex, bears responsibility for actions committed in the past		
25	by other members of the same race or sex;		

26	(8) Any individual should feel discomfort, guilt,
27	anguish, or any other form of psychological distress on
28	account of his or her race or sex;
29	(9) Meritocracy or traits such as a hard work ethic
30	are racist or sexist, or were created by a particular race
31	to oppress another race;
32	(10) Promote any form of race or sex stereotyping,
33	including ascribing character traits, values, moral and
34	ethical codes, privileges, status, or beliefs to a race,
35	sex, or an individual because of his or her race or sex; or
36	(11) Promote any form of race or sex scapegoating,
37	including assigning fault, blame, or conscious or
38	unconscious bias to one or more members of a race or sex and
39	including claims that, consciously or unconsciously, any
40	person is inherently racist, sexist, or inclined to oppress
41	others by virtue of their race or sex."; and further amend
42	said section by renumbering the remaining subsections
43	accordingly.
