Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 758, Page 20, Section 34.100, Line 22,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "34.800. 1. A public entity shall not enter into a  
4 contract with a company to acquire or dispose of services,  
5 supplies, information technology, or construction unless the  
6 contract includes a written certification that the company  
7 does not have and will not enforce a mandate that employees  
8 take a COVID-19 vaccination.

9 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms  
10 mean:

11 (1) "Company", any for-profit or not-for-profit  
12 organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint  
13 venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership,  
14 limited liability company, or other entity or business  
15 association, including all wholly owned subsidiaries,  
16 majority-owned subsidiaries, parent companies, or affiliates  
17 of those entities or business associations;

18 (2) "Public entity", the state of Missouri or any  
19 political subdivision thereof, including all boards,  
20 commissions, agencies, institutions, authorities, and bodies  
21 politic and corporate of the state created by or in  
22 accordance with state law or regulations.

23 3. Any contract that fails to comply with the  
24 provisions of this section shall be void against public  
25 policy."; and

26 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
