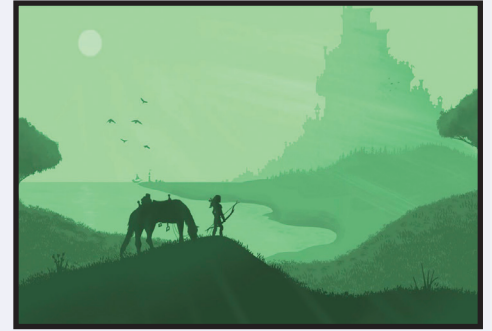
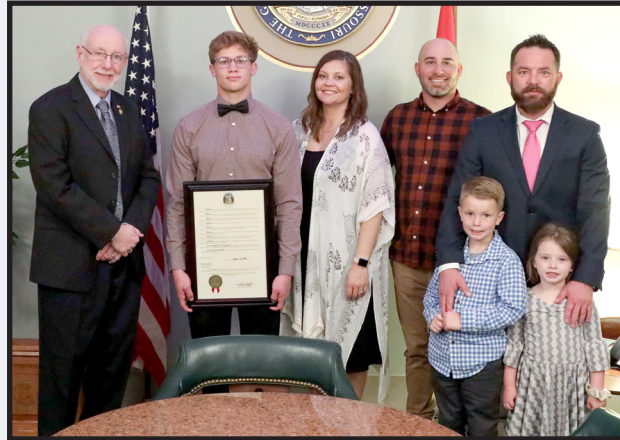
CELEBRATING COMMUNITY MILESTONES
