committed within the jurisdiction of the United States or a 23 24 state thereof; and 25 (2) Appear to be intended to: (a) Intimidate or coerce a civilian population; 26 27 (b) Influence the policy of a government by intimidation or coercion; or 28 (c) Affect the conduct of a government by mass 29 destruction, assassination, or kidnapping."; and 30 31 Further amend said bill, section 571.070, page 227, by 32 striking all of said section from the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 33 34 "571.070. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful 35 possession of a firearm if such person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and: 36 37 Such person has been convicted of a felony under 38 the laws of this state, or of a crime under the laws of any 39 state or of the United States which, if committed within this state, would be a felony; [or] 40 41 Such person is a fugitive from justice, is 42 habitually in an intoxicated or drugged condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent; 43 44 (3) Such person's name appears on the Terrorist Screening Center's No Fly List; or 45 46 (4) Such person is a member of a group of two or more 47 individuals, regardless if organized, that engages in or has 48 a subgroup that engages in international or domestic terrorism. For purposes of this subdivision, "terrorism" 49 50 means activities that: 51 Involve a violent act or acts dangerous to human (a) 52 life that are a violation of the criminal laws of the United States or a state thereof or that would be a criminal 53 violation if committed within the jurisdiction of the United 54

States or a state thereof; and

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- (b) Appear to be intended to:
- 57 a. Intimidate or coerce a civilian population;
- b. Influence the policy of a government by
