AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to patient examinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 191.240, to read as follows:

191.240. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

3 (1) "Health care provider", the same meaning given to
4 the term in section 191.900;

5 (2) "Patient examination", a prostate, anal, or pelvic
 6 examination.

7 2. A health care provider, or any student or trainee
8 under the supervision of a health care provider, shall not
9 knowingly perform a patient examination upon an anesthetized
10 or unconscious patient in a health care facility unless:

(1) The patient or a person authorized to make health
care decisions for the patient has given specific informed
consent to the patient examination;

14 (2) The patient examination is necessary for
 15 diagnostic or treatment purposes; or

(3) The collection of evidence through a forensic
examination, as defined under subsection 8 of section
595.220, for a suspected sexual assault on the anesthetized

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or unconscious patient is necessary because the evidence
will be lost or the patient is unable to give informed
consent due to a medical condition.

3. A health care provider shall notify a patient of
any patient examination performed under subsection 2 of this
section.

4. A health care provider who violates the provisions
of this section, or who supervises a student or trainee who
violates the provisions of this section, shall be subject to
discipline by any licensing board that licenses the health
care provider.

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
