AN ACT

To repeal section 21.851, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the joint committee on disaster preparedness and awareness.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Section 21.851, RSMo, is repealed and one new
- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 21.851,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 21.851. 1. There is hereby established a permanent
- 2 joint committee of the general assembly, which shall be
- 3 known as the "Joint Committee on Disaster Preparedness and
- 4 Awareness" and shall be composed of the following members:
- 5 (1) Three members of the senate to be appointed by the
- 6 president pro tempore of the senate;
- 7 (2) Two members of the senate to be appointed by the
- 8 minority floor leader of the senate;
- 9 (3) Three members of the house of representatives to
- 10 be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 11 and
- 12 (4) Two members of the house of representatives to be
- 13 appointed by the minority floor leader of the house of
- 14 representatives[;
- 15 (5) The director of the department of public safety,
- or his or her designee;

- (7) The adjutant general of the state, or his or her 19

- 21 2. A majority of the members of the committee shall
- 22 constitute a quorum, but the concurrence of a majority of
- 23 the members shall be required for the determination of any
- 24 matter within the committee's duties.
- 25 The joint committee shall make a continuous study
- 26 and investigation into issues relating to disaster
- preparedness and awareness including, but not limited to, 27
- the following areas: 28
- Natural and manmade disasters; 29 (1)
- State and local preparedness for floods; 30 (2)
- State and local preparedness for tornados, 31
- 32 blizzards, and other severe storms;
- 33 Food and energy resiliency; (4)
- 34 (5) Cybersecurity;
- 35 The budget reserve fund established under Article
- IV, Section 27(a) of the Missouri Constitution; 36
- 37 The protection of vulnerable populations in
- intermediate care facilities and skilled nursing facilities 38
- as those terms are defined in section 198.006; and 39
- 40 (8) Premises that have been previously contaminated
- with radioactive material. 41
- The joint committee shall collect information from 42
- the department of public safety, the department of 43
- agriculture, and the office of adjutant general. 44
- The joint committee shall compile a full report of 45
- its activities for submission to the general assembly. The 46
- report shall be submitted not later than January first of 47
- even-numbered years and may include any recommendations 48

- which the committee may have for legislative action. The report may also include an analysis and statement of the manner in which statutory provisions relating to disaster preparedness and awareness are being executed.
- 53 [5.] 6. The joint committee may employ such personnel 54 as it deems necessary to carry out the duties imposed by 55 this section, within the limits of any appropriation for 56 such purpose.
- 57 [6.] 7. The members of the committee shall serve 58 without compensation, but any actual and necessary expenses 59 incurred in the performance of the committee's official 60 duties by the joint committee, its members, and any staff 61 assigned to the committee shall be paid from the joint 62 contingent fund.
 - [7. This section shall expire on December 31, 2022]
 - 8. The joint committee shall select a chairperson and vice-chairperson, one of whom shall be a member of the senate and the other a member of the house of representatives, to serve for a two-year term.
