## AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to electric vehicle charging station requirements.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto  
2 one new section, to be known as section 67.288, to read as  
3 follows:

**67.288. 1. For purposes of this section, the  
2 following terms mean:**

3 (1) "Electric vehicle", any vehicle that operates,  
4 either partially or exclusively, on electrical energy from  
5 the grid or an off-board source that is stored onboard for a  
6 motive purpose;

7 (2) "Electric vehicle charging station", a public or  
8 private parking space that is served by battery charging  
9 station equipment that has as its primary purpose the  
10 transfer of electric energy by conductive or inductive means  
11 to a battery or other energy storage device in an electric  
12 vehicle.

13 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any  
14 political subdivision that adopts an ordinance, resolution,  
15 regulation, code, or policy that requires installation of  
16 electric vehicle charging stations at any nonautomotive  
17 fueling station business shall pay all costs associated with  
18 the installation, maintenance, and operation of the electric

19 vehicle charging stations. No political subdivision shall  
20 adopt any ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, or policy  
21 that requires more than five electric vehicle charging  
22 stations per parking lot located at any nonautomotive  
23 fueling station, or infrastructure for future installation  
24 of more than five vehicle charging stations located at any  
25 nonautomotive fueling station, and such ordinances,  
26 resolutions, regulations, codes, or policies shall apply  
27 only to parking lots with more than thirty parking spaces  
28 designated for parking.

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
