AN ACT

To amend chapter 337, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to mental health treatment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 337, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 two new sections, to be known as sections 337.800 and 337.801,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 337.800. 1. There is hereby established within the
- 2 department of commerce and insurance the "Dialectical
- 3 Behavior Therapy Task Force" to consist of the following
- 4 members:
- 5 (1) The director of the department of commerce and
- 6 insurance, or his or her designee, who shall serve as chair;
- 7 (2) The director of the department of mental health,
- 8 or his or her designee, who shall serve as vice chair;
- 9 (3) One member of the senate, to be appointed by the
- 10 president pro tempore of the senate;
- 11 (4) One member of the senate, to be appointed by the
- 12 minority floor leader of the senate;
- 13 (5) One member of the house of representatives, to be
- 14 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 15 (6) One member of the house of representatives, to be
- 16 appointed by the minority floor leader of the house of
- 17 representatives;

18 (7) Three individuals certified by the Dialectical
19 Behavior Therapy Linehan Board of Certification as
20 dialectical behavior therapy providers, to be appointed by

- 22 (8) The executive director of the Missouri state 23 committee of psychologists, or his or her designee;
- (9) One representative of Aspire Advocates for Mental Health, to be appointed by the director of the department of commerce and insurance based on recommendation of Aspire Advocates for Mental Health:
- 28 (10) One representative of the National Alliance on
 29 Mental Illness, to be appointed by the director of the
 30 department of commerce and insurance based on recommendation
 31 of the National Alliance on Mental Illness; and
- 32 (11) One representative of the American Foundation for 33 Suicide Prevention, to be appointed by the director of the 34 department of commerce and insurance based on recommendation 35 of the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention.
- 2. A majority of the members of the task force shall constitute a quorum, but the concurrence of a majority of the members shall be required for the determination of any matter within the task force's duties. Any vacancy on the task force shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.
- 3. The task force shall hold its first meeting no
 later than October 31, 2023, at which time the task force
 shall receive public testimony regarding dialectical
 behavior therapy and determine when further meetings shall
 occur, and the focus of such meetings. The task force shall
 hold at least two meetings in total.
- 48 4. The task force shall compile a report of its
 49 activities for submission to the general assembly and the

50 governor, which shall include specific recommendations 51 regarding the following:

(1) Standards and procedures for obtaining
certification in dialectical behavior therapy for providers
and programs, to be derived from the Marsha Linehan
Dialectical Behavior Therapy model of treatment;

- (2) Standards and procedures for temporary or provisional certification in dialectical behavior therapy for providers and programs in the process of obtaining certification in dialectical behavior therapy;
- 60 (3) Standards and procedures for providers from other 61 states to obtain a comparable certification based on 62 certifications issued in other states; and
 - (4) Any other issue the task force considers relevant.
- 5. The department of commerce and insurance shall provide such research, clerical, technical, and other services as the task force may require in its duties under this section.
- No later than October 31, 2024, the task force 68 shall provide to the general assembly, the governor, and the 69 70 director of the department of commerce and insurance a written report detailing its findings and recommendations, 71 72 including identifying any recommendations that may require 73 enabling legislation in addition to the authority specified in section 337.801. The task force shall expire on October 74 31, 2024. 75
- 7. Members shall serve on the task force without
 compensation, but may, at the discretion of the director of
 the department of commerce and insurance, be reimbursed for
 actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of
 their official duties as members of the task force.

337.801. 1. The department of commerce and insurance shall promulgate rules regarding the following:

- 7 (2) Standards and procedures for temporary or

- 11 (3) Standards and procedures for providers from other
- 12 states to obtain a comparable certification based on
- 13 certifications issued in other states.
- 14 2. Proposed rules under this section shall incorporate
- 15 the recommendations made by the dialectical behavior therapy
- 16 task force in its report under section 337.800.
- 3. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is
- 18 defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
- 19 authority delegated in this section shall become effective
- 20 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
- 21 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
- 22 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and
- 23 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
- 24 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective
- 25 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
- 26 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
- 27 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,
- 28 2023, shall be invalid and void.
- 4. This section shall take effect on November 1, 2024.
