AN ACT

To amend chapter 163, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to educational funding for students being treated at a residential treatment facility.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 163, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 163.063, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 163.063. 1. For pupils who are residents of a school
- 2 district; being treated at a residential treatment facility
- 3 or a similar such facility located in such school district;
- 4 unable to attend the public school district in which the
- 5 residential treatment facility is located, either because
- 6 the pupil may be a safety risk or has behavioral conditions
- 7 that support the need to educate the pupil on such
- 8 facility's site or campus; and are being provided
- 9 educational services in such residential care or similar
- 10 facility, the school district in which the residential
- 11 treatment facility is located shall, for any such pupil
- 12 receiving all of their educational services within the
- 13 facility, remit to such treatment facility a sum equal to
- 14 ninety-five percent of the proportionate share, on a per-
- 15 weighted average daily attendance basis, of the local and
- 16 state funding received by the district that is attributable
- 17 to such pupil in addition to any other moneys available to
- 18 the school district through the department of elementary and

19 secondary education for such pupil. For pupils receiving a 20 portion, but not all, of their educational services within 21 such facility, such facility shall be entitled to ninety-22 five percent of the proportionate share, on a per-weighted 23 average daily attendance basis, of the local and state 24 funding received by the district, in addition to any other moneys available to the school district through the 25 26 department of elementary and secondary education for such 27 pupil, that is attributable to the amount of time such pupil 28 received educational services at the facility. For purposes 29 of calculating state aid payments under 163.011 and 163.031, and receiving federal aid, pupils who qualify under this 30 subsection shall continue to be enumerated in the enrollment 31 32 of the school district in which such treatment facility is 33 located.

For pupils who are being treated at a residential 2. treatment facility or a similar such facility; are unable to attend the public school district in which the residential treatment facility is located, either because the pupil may be a safety risk or has behavioral conditions that support the need to educate the pupil on such facility's site or campus; are being provided educational services in such residential care or similar facility; and who were enrolled in a school district other than the school district in which the facility was located at the time the pupil was admitted to the treatment facility, the district in which the student was enrolled at the time the pupil was admitted to the facility shall remit to the facility an amount equal to ninety-five percent of the proportionate share, on a perweighted average daily attendance basis, of the local and state funding received by the district that is attributable to such pupil in addition to any other moneys available to

- 3. Educational costs of the residential treatment facility that are not covered by the payment mechanism established in subsections 1 and 2 of this section may be reimbursed as provided in the provisions of section 167.126.
- 4. Costs associated with providing educational services to pupils who were not enrolled in a school district located in this state at the time the pupil was admitted to a residential treatment facility shall be reimbursed as provided in the provisions of section 167.126.
- 5. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent a residential treatment facility and school district from mutually agreeing to a financial arrangement that deviates from the provisions of this section.
