AN ACT

To repeal sections 307.350, 307.355, and 307.380, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to motor vehicle safety inspections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 307.350, 307.355, and 307.380, RSMo,

- 2 are repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to
- 3 be known as sections 307.350, 307.355, and 307.380, to read as
- 4 follows:

307.350. 1. The owner of every motor vehicle as

- 2 defined in section 301.010 which is required to be
- 3 registered in this state, except:
- 4 (1) Motor vehicles having less than one hundred fifty
- 5 thousand miles, for the ten-year period following their
- 6 model year of manufacture[, excluding prior salvage vehicles
- 7 immediately following a rebuilding process and vehicles
- 8 subject to the provisions of section 307.380];
- 9 (2) Those motor vehicles which are engaged in
- 10 interstate commerce and are proportionately registered in
- 11 this state with the Missouri highway reciprocity commission,
- 12 although the owner may request that such vehicle be
- 13 inspected by an official inspection station, and a peace
- 14 officer may stop and inspect such vehicles to determine
- 15 whether the mechanical condition is in compliance with the
- 16 safety regulations established by the United States
- 17 Department of Transportation; and

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

18 Historic motor vehicles registered pursuant to 19 section 301.131; 20 (4)Vehicles registered in excess of twenty-four thousand pounds for a period of less than twelve months; 21 22 shall submit such vehicles to a biennial inspection of their mechanism and equipment in accordance with the provisions of 23 sections 307.350 to 307.390 and obtain a certificate of 24 inspection and approval and a sticker, seal, or other device 25 from a duly authorized official inspection station. 26 27 inspection, except the inspection of school buses which shall be made at the time provided in section 307.375, shall 28 29 be made at the time prescribed in the rules and regulations issued by the superintendent of the Missouri state highway 30 31 patrol; but the inspection of a vehicle under this section shall not be made more than sixty days prior to the date of 32 application for registration [or within sixty days of when a 33 34 vehicle's registration is transferred; however, if a vehicle was purchased from a motor vehicle dealer and a valid 35 inspection had been made within sixty days of the purchase 36 37 date, the new owner shall be able to utilize an inspection performed within ninety days prior to the application for 38 39 registration or transfer]. Any vehicle manufactured as an even-numbered model year vehicle shall be inspected and 40 approved pursuant to the safety inspection program 41 established pursuant to sections 307.350 to 307.390 in each 42 even-numbered calendar year and any such vehicle 43 manufactured as an odd-numbered model year vehicle shall be 44 inspected and approved pursuant to sections 307.350 to 45 307.390 in each odd-numbered year. The certificate of 46 inspection and approval shall be a sticker, seal, or other 47 48 device or combination thereof, as the superintendent of the

49 Missouri state highway patrol prescribes by regulation and

- 50 shall be displayed upon the motor vehicle or trailer as
- 51 prescribed by the regulations established by him. The
- 52 replacement of certificates of inspection and approval which
- 53 are lost or destroyed shall be made by the superintendent of
- 54 the Missouri state highway patrol under regulations
- 55 prescribed by him.
- 56 2. For the purpose of obtaining an inspection only, it
- 57 shall be lawful to operate a vehicle over the most direct
- 58 route between the owner's usual place of residence and an
- 59 inspection station of such owner's choice, notwithstanding
- 60 the fact that the vehicle does not have a current state
- 61 registration license. It shall also be lawful to operate
- 62 such a vehicle from an inspection station to another place
- 63 where repairs may be made and to return the vehicle to the
- 64 inspection station notwithstanding the absence of a current
- 65 state registration license.
- 3. No person whose motor vehicle was duly inspected
- 67 and approved as provided in this section shall be required
- 68 to have the same motor vehicle again inspected and approved
- 69 for the sole reason that such person wishes to obtain a set
- 70 of any special personalized license plates available
- 71 pursuant to section 301.144 or a set of any license plates
- 72 available pursuant to section 301.142, prior to the
- 73 expiration date of such motor vehicle's current registration.
- 74 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 307.390,
- 75 violation of this section shall be deemed an infraction.
 - 307.355. 1. No state registration license to operate
- 2 the type of vehicle required to be inspected by section
- 3 307.350 may be transferred or issued during a biennial
- 4 registration year in which the vehicle is required to be
- 5 inspected unless the application is accompanied by a

6 certificate of inspection and approval issued no more than

7 sixty days prior to the date of application, or in the case

- 8 of school buses, which will be required to be inspected
- 9 annually as provided in section 307.375, except:
- 10 (1) The director of revenue may transfer or issue a
- 11 state registration license to the type of vehicle required
- 12 to be inspected by section 307.350 without a certificate of
- 13 inspection and approval accompanying the application if the
- 14 director has satisfactory evidence that the vehicle was not
- 15 in the state of Missouri at any time during the sixty days
- 16 prior to the date of application; however, the owner of
- 17 every such vehicle must submit the vehicle for inspection
- 18 and obtain a certificate of inspection and approval within
- 19 ten days after the vehicle is first returned to the state of
- 20 Missouri;
- 21 (2) The director of revenue shall renew a vehicle's
- 22 registration license without a certificate of inspection and
- 23 approval accompanying the application if satisfactory
- 24 documentary evidence is presented at the time of application
- 25 that the license being renewed was properly transferred
- 26 within a six-month period prior to the expiration of the
- 27 license being renewed or that the vehicle for which the
- 28 registration is being issued was issued a registration for a
- 29 period of less than one year for the registration period
- 30 just expiring.
- 31 2. At the seller's expense, every used motor vehicle
- 32 of the type required to be inspected by section 307.350
- 33 shall immediately prior to sale be fully inspected
- 34 regardless of any current certificate of inspection and
- 35 approval, and an appropriate new certificate of inspection
- 36 and approval, sticker, seal, or other device shall be
- obtained. The inspection, except the inspection of school

38 buses which shall be made at the time provided in section 39 307.375, shall be made at the time prescribed in the rules 40 and regulations issued by the superintendent of the Missouri 41 state highway patrol; but the inspection of a vehicle under 42 this section shall not be made more than sixty days prior to 43 the date of application for registration or transfer; 44 however, if a vehicle was purchased from a motor vehicle 45 dealer and a valid inspection had been made within sixty days of the purchase date, the new owner shall be able to 46 47 utilize an inspection performed within ninety days prior to the application for registration or transfer. 48 49 subsection shall not apply to motor vehicles having less than fifty thousand miles, for the three-year period 50 51 following their model year of manufacture, except that it 52 shall apply to all prior salvage vehicles immediately 53 following a rebuilding process and all vehicles subject to 54 the provisions of section 307.380. At or before the time a buyer takes physical possession of the vehicle, the seller 55 shall present a certificate of inspection and approval, or a 56 document stating that at the time of purchase the vehicle 57 58 had less than fifty thousand miles and was within three years of the model year of manufacture. 59 60

3. If due to interstate operation a commercial motor vehicle as defined in section 301.010 or a trailer of the type required to be inspected is required to obtain full fee registration in this and any other state during the same calendar year, no Missouri certificate of inspection and approval is required if the vehicle bears evidence that a current valid inspection sticker or decal was issued by such other state in which the vehicle is registered; provided that the sticker or decal issued by such other state is valid for the registration period in this state.

70 [3.] 4. After a commercial motor vehicle as defined in 71 section 301.010 has been registered for the current year, no 72 certificate of inspection and approval is required when a local commercial motor vehicle license is changed to a 73 beyond-local commercial motor vehicle license or when the 74 75 licensed gross weight is changed during the licensed period. 1. Every vehicle of the type required to be 2 inspected upon having been involved in an accident and when 3 so directed by a police officer must be inspected and an 4 official certificate of inspection and approval, sticker, seal or other device be obtained for such vehicle before it 5 is again operated on the highways of this state. 6 seller's expense every used motor vehicle of the type 7 8 required to be inspected by section 307.350 shall 9 immediately prior to sale be fully inspected regardless of 10 any current certificate of inspection and approval, and an 11 appropriate new certificate of inspection and approval, 12 sticker, seal or other device shall be obtained.] 13 Nothing contained in the provisions of this section 14 shall be construed to prohibit a dealer or any other person from selling a vehicle without a certificate of inspection 15 and approval if the vehicle is sold for junk, salvage, or 16 for rebuilding, or for vehicles sold at public auction or 17 from dealer to dealer. The purchaser of any vehicle which 18 is purchased for junk, salvage, or for rebuilding shall give 19 20 to the seller an affidavit, on a form prescribed by the 21 superintendent of the Missouri state highway patrol, stating 22 that the vehicle is being purchased for one of the reasons 23 stated herein. No vehicle of the type required to be inspected by section 307.350 which is purchased as junk, 24 salvage, or for rebuilding shall again be registered in this 25 state until the owner has submitted the vehicle for 26

- 28 inspection and approval, sticker, seal or other device for
- 29 such vehicle.
- 30 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 307.390,
- 31 violation of this section shall be deemed an infraction.
