## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 135, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to electric vehicle tax credits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 135, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 135.1680, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 135.1680. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms mean:
- 3 (1) "Electric vehicle", new battery electric vehicles
- 4 (BEV) and new plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV) which
- 5 are titled under the laws of this state;
- 6 (2) "Qualified purchase", any purchase by a taxpayer
- of an electric vehicle in a given tax year;
- 8 (3) "Tax credit", a credit against the tax otherwise
- 9 due under chapter 143, excluding withholding tax imposed
- 10 under sections 143.191 to 143.265;
- 11 (4) "Taxpayer", any individual subject to the state
- 12 income tax imposed under chapter 143.
- For all tax years beginning on or after January 1,
- 14 2024, a taxpayer shall be allowed to claim a tax credit
- 15 against the taxpayer's state tax liability for each
- 16 qualified purchase made by the taxpayer during the tax
- 17 year. The amount of the tax credit shall be two thousand
- 18 five hundred dollars per qualified purchase.

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- 19 3. The tax credits authorized under this section may
- 20 be carried forward up to three subsequent tax years but
- 21 shall be nonrefundable, and shall not be assigned,
- transferred, sold, or otherwise conveyed.
- 23 4. The department of revenue shall promulgate all
- 24 necessary rules and regulations to administer the provisions
- 25 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that
- term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under
- 27 the authority delegated in this section shall become
- 28 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of
- 29 the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
- 30 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and
- 31 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
- 32 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective
- date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
- 34 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
- 35 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,
- 36 2023, shall be invalid and void.
- 37 5. Under section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:
- 38 (1) The provisions of this section shall automatically
- 39 sunset December thirty-first six years after the effective
- 40 date of this section unless reauthorized by an act of the
- 41 general assembly;
- 42 (2) If the provisions of this section are
- 43 reauthorized, such provisions shall automatically sunset
- 44 December thirty-first twelve years after the effective date
- 45 of the reauthorization; and
- 46 (3) This section shall terminate on September first of
- 47 the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in
- 48 which the provisions of this section are sunset.

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
