JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment repealing section 39(e) of article III of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to riverboat gambling.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2024, or at a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article III of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Section 39(e), article III, Constitution of Missouri, is repealed and one new section adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 39(e), to read as follows:

Section 39(e). 1. The general assembly is authorized to permit upon the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers only, 2 3 which shall include artificial spaces that contain water and that are within 1000 feet of the closest edge of the main 4 5 channel of either of those rivers, lotteries, gift 6 enterprises and games of chance to be conducted on excursion gambling boats and floating facilities. Any license issued 7 before or after the adoption date of this amendment for any 8 9 excursion gambling boat or floating facility located in any 10 such artificial space shall be deemed to be authorized by

13 [NOTICE: You are advised that the proposed constitutional 14 amendment may be construed to change, repeal, or modify by 15 implication Article III, Sections 39, 39(9), and 39(e).]

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 16 2. contrary, lotteries, gift enterprises, and games of chance 17 may be conducted on excursion gambling boats and floating 18 19 facilities licensed by the Missouri gaming commission upon 20 the portion of the Osage River from the Missouri River to 21 the Bagnell Dam, which shall include artificial spaces that 22 contain water and that are within 1000 feet of the high 23 water mark of the closest edge of the main channel of the river, as defined by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. 24

3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 25 26 contrary, in addition to such licenses as have been 27 authorized prior to January 1, 2023, the Missouri Gaming Commission shall issue one additional excursion gambling 28 29 boat license. Such license shall be issued only to an 30 excursion gambling boat that will operate upon the portion 31 of the Osage River from the Missouri River to the Bagnell 32 Dam.
