## AN ACT

To amend chapter 340, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to entities authorized to regulate the practice of veterinary medicine.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 340, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto 2 one new section, to be known as section 340.201, to read as 3 follows:

340.201. 1. The general assembly hereby occupies and 2 preempts the entire field of legislation concerning the 3 practice of veterinary medicine regulated under this chapter. A political subdivision of this state is preempted 4 5 from enacting, maintaining, or enforcing any order, 6 ordinance, rule, regulation, policy, or other similar 7 measure that prohibits, restricts, limits, regulates, 8 controls, directs, or interferes with the practice of 9 veterinary medicine.

Nothing in this section shall preclude or preempt a
political subdivision of this state from exercising its
lawful authority to regulate zoning or land use, to enforce
a building or fire code regulation, to impose a tax or
license fee for the privilege of carrying on the profession
of veterinary medicine consistent with the laws regulating

such taxes or license fees, to require vaccinations and 16 licensing of animals kept within the boundaries of the 17 political subdivision, to prohibit animal abuse, or 18 otherwise to regulate for the general health, safety, 19 20 sanitation, and welfare as long as the order, ordinance, 21 rule, regulation, policy, or other measure does not interfere with, restrict, or limit the ability of a lawfully 22 licensed person from engaging in any act or performing any 23 24 procedure that falls within the professionally recognized scope of practice of veterinary medicine or otherwise 25 interfere with a veterinarian-client-patient relationship. 26
