Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 835, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 5,

2 by striking "institutions" and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following: "transactions"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 2, section 30.753, line
5 41, by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "34.710. 1. The state, any agency of the state, any
7 political subdivision of the state, or any instrumentality
8 thereof, when engaged in procuring or letting contracts for
9 any purpose shall ensure that bidders, offerors,
10 contractors, or subcontractors are not discriminated against
11 or given preferential treatment based on an environmental,
12 social, and governance score.

13 2. For purposes of this section, the term
14 "environmental, social, and governance score" means an
15 evaluation conducted by an entity that takes into
16 consideration one or more of the following:

17 (1) The use of energy and raw materials by the bidder,
18 offeror, contractor, or subcontractor;

19 (2) Whether the bidder, offeror, contractor, or
20 subcontractor spends funds on social welfare or makes
21 charitable donations;

22 (3) The environmental policies of the bidder, offeror,
23 contractor, or subcontractor; and

24 (4) The information transparency of the bidder,
25 offeror, contractor, or subcontractor."; and

26 Further amend said bill, page 4, section 110.075, line
27 57, by inserting after all of said line the following:

28 "347.800. 1. No limited liability company registered
29 pursuant to this chapter shall be discriminated against or
30 given preferential treatment based on an environmental,
31 social, and governance score.

32 2. For purposes of this section, the term
33 "environmental, social, and governance score" means an
34 evaluation conducted by an entity that takes into
35 consideration one or more of the following:

36 (1) The use of energy and raw materials by the limited
37 liability company;

38 (2) Whether the limited liability company spends funds
39 on social welfare or makes charitable donations;

40 (3) The environmental policies of the limited
41 liability company; and

42 (4) The information transparency of the limited
43 liability company.

44 351.018. 1. No corporation registered pursuant to
45 this chapter shall be discriminated against or given
46 preferential treatment based on an environmental, social,
47 and governance score.

48 2. For purposes of this section, the term
49 "environmental, social, and governance score" means an
50 evaluation conducted by an entity that takes into
51 consideration one or more of the following:

52 (1) The use of energy and raw materials by the
53 corporation;

54 (2) Whether the corporation spends funds on social
55 welfare or makes charitable donations;

56 (3) The environmental policies of the corporation; and

57 (4) The information transparency of the corporation.";
