Amend SS/House Bill No.  $\underline{1713}$ , Page  $\underline{1}$ , Section  $\underline{A}$ , Line  $\underline{7}$ ,

2	by inserting after all of said line the following:
3	"37.1300. For the purposes of sections 37.1300 to
4	37.1330, the following terms mean:
5	(1) "Council", the Missouri geospatial advisory
6	council established in section 37.1310;
7	(2) "Geographic information system (GIS)", a computer
8	system for capturing, storing, checking, and displaying data
9	related to positions on the Earth's surface that enables
10	easily seeing, analyzing, and understanding patterns and
11	relationships;
12	(3) "Geospatial", relating to or denoting data that is
13	associated with a particular location;
14	(4) "Missouri Spatial Data Information Service" or
15	"MSDIS", Missouri's primary spatial data clearinghouse
16	responsible for collecting and distributing vector data,
17	aerial photography, and light detection and ranging
18	elevation data that are generated, updated, and funded by
19	state, local, and regional agencies and governments.
20	37.1310. There is hereby established within the office
21	of administration the "Missouri Geospatial Advisory
22	Council", which is charged with advising the state in
23	ensuring the availability, implementation, and enhancement
24	of a statewide geospatial data infrastructure. The council
25	shall be established within the office of the commissioner
26	of administration.

27	37.1320. 1. The council shall consist of members as
28	<pre>follows:</pre>
29	(1) The commissioner of administration, or the
30	commissioner's designee;
31	(2) The director of the department of agriculture, or
32	the director's designee;
33	(3) The director of the department of conservation, or
34	the director's designee;
35	(4) The director of the department of economic
36	development, or the director's designee;
37	(5) The director of the department of elementary and
38	secondary education, or the director's designee;
39	(6) The director of the department of health and
40	senior services, or the director's designee;
41	(7) The director of the department of natural
42	resources, or the director's designee;
43	(8) The Missouri military advocate, or the advocate's
44	designee;
45	(9) The adjutant general of the department of the
46	national guard, or the adjutant general's designee;
47	(10) The director of the department of public safety,
48	or the director's designee;
49	(11) The director of the department of revenue, or the
50	director's designee;
51	(12) The director of the department of social
52	services, or the director's designee;
53	(13) The director of the department of transportation,
54	or the director's designee;
55	(14) The director of the United States Geological
56	Survey, or the director's designee;
57	(15) The director of the United States Department of
58	Agriculture - Natural Resource Conservation Service, or the
59	director's designee;

60	(16) The director of the Missouri 911 service board,
61	or the director's designee;
62	(17) The president of the University of Missouri
63	system, or the president's designee;
64	(18) The director of the Missouri Spatial Data
65	Information Service, or the director's designee;
66	(19) The director of the National Geospatial
67	Intelligence Agency-West, or the director's designee;
68	(20) A member of the state senate, appointed by the
69	<pre>president pro tempore of the senate;</pre>
70	(21) A member of the house of representatives,
71	appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
72	(22) Thirteen citizens of Missouri, appointed by the
73	commissioner of administration. Such individuals shall
74	represent a geographic balance from within the state,
75	representing both rural and urban areas with at least one
76	individual from each of the seven Missouri economic
77	development regions, as determined by the Missouri economic
78	research information center. Such individuals shall
79	additionally represent city, county, and local government;
80	the private sector; public safety; and academia; and
81	(23) Additional subject matter experts may participate
82	in activities as non-council members.
83	2. Appointed members of the council shall serve three-
84	year terms and shall serve until their successors are
85	appointed. Vacancies on the council shall be filled in the
86	same manner as the original appointment and such member
87	appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term.
88	3. The council shall meet monthly and as otherwise
89	required by the commissioner of the office of administration.
90	4. The council shall designate from its members a
91	chair and chair-elect for one-year terms and shall adopt
92	written guidelines to govern the management of the council.

- 93 <u>5. Each member of the council shall serve without</u>
  94 <u>compensation but may be reimbursed for his or her actual and</u>
  95 <u>necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his or her</u>
  96 duties as a member of the council.
