

SENATE SUBSTITUTE
FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 964
AN ACT

To amend chapters 9, 226, and 227, RSMo, by adding thereto eight new sections relating to state designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 9, 226, and 227, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto eight new sections, to be known as sections 9.367, 9.386, 9.394, 9.402, 9.500, 226.1170, 227.841, and 227.854, to read as follows:

9.367. August sixth of each year is hereby designated as "Chris Sifford Day" in Missouri. In the year 2000, an airplane carrying Chris Sifford along with Governor Mel Carnahan and Roger "Randy" Carnahan tragically went down and took with it the lives of three great Missourians. Chris is remembered to have been a loving and devoted public servant who was a friend to all. Missourians are encouraged to reflect on the lives and legacies of these three men and to recognize and appreciate the hardworking public servants of this state.

9.386. The last Saturday of April of each year is hereby designated as "Emmett Kelly Day" in Missouri. The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate events and activities to honor the life of Emmett Kelly, who was a famous circus performer, also known as Weary Willie, from Houston, Missouri.

9.394. May sixth of every year shall be known and designated as "Advanced Practice Registered Nurses Appreciation Day" in Missouri. The citizens of this state are encourages to observe the day with appropriate

5 activities and events to recognize and support the work and
6 contributions that advanced practice registered nurses
7 provide to the health care of citizens of this state.

2 9.402. May eighth each year is hereby designated as
3 "Amyloidosis Awareness Day" in Missouri. The citizens of
4 this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate
5 events and activities to raise awareness of this rare and
6 life-threatening disease.

2 9.500. Beginning January 1, 2025, in order for a day
3 to be designated by the general assembly in honor of a
4 deceased individual, such individual shall be deceased for
5 at least three years. If the individual was killed in
6 combat while on active duty in the military or killed in the
7 line of duty as a first responder, such individual shall be
8 deceased for at least one year.

2 226.1170. The department of transportation, in
3 consultation with the Ozark Highland Distillers Guild, shall
4 erect and maintain suitable markings and informational signs
5 designating the Ozark Highlands Spirits Region in accordance
6 with the map produced pursuant to subsection 4 of section
7 311.028. Signs shall be located along highways approaching
8 or entering the region, with the costs to be paid by private
9 donation.

2 227.841. The portion of U.S. Highway 50 from CRD Nowak
3 Road continuing east to CRD Danz Road in Gasconade County
4 shall be designated as "Police Chief Mason Griffith Memorial
5 Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and
6 maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with
7 the costs to be paid by the department.

2 227.854. The portion of U.S. Highway 63 from the south
3 end of CRD 637 loop continuing north through the City of
4 Freeburg to Dogwood Street in Osage County shall be
5 designated the "POW/MIA SSG Paul Hasenbeck Memorial
6 Highway".

5 Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and
6 maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with
7 the costs to be paid by the department of transportation.
