Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 1659, Page 142, Section 492.304, Line 58,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "509.520. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
4 the contrary, beginning August 28, 2023, pleadings,
5 attachments, exhibits filed with the court in any case, as
6 well as any judgments or orders issued by the court, or
7 other records of the court shall not include the following
8 confidential and personal identifying information:

9 (1) The full Social Security number of any party or
10 any child;

11 (2) The full credit card number, financial institution
12 account number, personal identification number, or password
13 used to secure an account of any party;

14 (3) The full motor vehicle operator license number;

15 (4) **[Victim]** Information**[, including the name,**
16 **address, and other contact information of the]** concerning a
17 victim or witness in a criminal case that is confidential as
18 otherwise provided by statute or as prescribed in the
19 Missouri supreme court rules of criminal procedure or
20 operating rules;

21 (5) **[Witness information, including the name, address,**
22 **and other contact information of the witness ;**

23 **[(6)]** Any other full state identification number;

24 **[(7)]** (6) The name, address, and date of birth of a
25 minor and, if applicable, any next friend; **[or**

26 (8)] (7) The full date of birth of any party; however,
27 the year of birth shall be made available, except for a
28 minor; or

29 (8) Any other information redacted for good cause by
30 order of the court.

31 2. The information provided under subsection 1 of this
32 section shall be provided in a confidential information
33 filing sheet contemporaneously filed with the court or
34 entered by the court, which shall not be subject to public
35 inspection or availability.

36 3. Nothing in this section shall preclude an entity
37 including, but not limited to, a financial institution,
38 insurer, insurance support organization, or consumer
39 reporting agency that is otherwise permitted by law to
40 access state court records from using a person's unique
41 identifying information to match such information contained
42 in a court record to validate that person's record.

43 4. The Missouri supreme court shall promulgate rules
44 to administer this section.

45 5. Contemporaneously with the filing of every petition
46 for dissolution of marriage, legal separation, motion for
47 modification, action to establish paternity, and petition or
48 motion for support or custody of a minor child, the filing
49 party shall file a confidential case filing sheet with the
50 court which shall not be subject to public inspection and
51 which provides:

52 (1) The name and address of the current employer and
53 the Social Security number of the petitioner or movant, if a
54 person;

55 (2) If known to the petitioner or movant, the name and
56 address of the current employer and the Social Security
57 number of the respondent; and

58 (3) The names, dates of birth, and Social Security
59 numbers of any children subject to the action.

60 6. Contemporaneously with the filing of every
61 responsive pleading petition for dissolution of marriage,
62 legal separation, motion for modification, action to
63 establish paternity, and petition or motion for support or
64 custody of a minor child, the responding party shall file a
65 confidential case filing sheet with the court which shall
66 not be subject to public inspection and which provides:

67 (1) The name and address of the current employer and
68 the Social Security number of the responding party, if a
69 person;

70 (2) If known to the responding party, the name and
71 address of the current employer and the Social Security
72 number of the petitioner or movant; and

73 (3) The names, dates of birth, and Social Security
74 numbers of any children subject to the action.

75 7. The full Social Security number of any party or
76 child subject to an order of custody or support shall be
77 retained by the court on the confidential case filing sheet
78 or other confidential record maintained in conjunction with
79 the administration of the case. The full credit card number
80 or other financial account number of any party may be
81 retained by the court on a confidential record if it is
82 necessary to maintain the number in conjunction with the
83 administration of the case.

84 8. Any document described in subsection 1 of this
85 section shall, in lieu of the full number, include only the
86 last four digits of any such number.

87 9. Except as provided in section 452.430, the clerk
88 shall not be required to redact any document described in
89 subsection 1 of this section issued or filed before August
90 28, 2009, prior to releasing the document to the public.

91 10. For good cause shown, the court may release
92 information contained on the confidential case filing sheet;
93 except that, any state agency acting under authority of
94 chapter 454 shall have access to information contained
95 herein without court order in carrying out their official
96 duty."; and
