Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 1659, Page 27, Section 197.135, Line 82,

- 2 by inserting after all of said line the following:
- 3 "210.1012. 1. There is hereby created a statewide
- 4 program called the "Amber Alert System" referred to in this
- 5 section as the "system" to aid in the identification and
- 6 location of an abducted child.
- 7 2. For the purposes of this section, "abducted child"
- 8 means a child whose whereabouts are unknown and who is:
- 9 (1) Less than eighteen years of age and reasonably
- 10 believed to be the victim of the crime of kidnapping or
- 11 kidnapping in the first degree as defined by section 565.110
- 12 as determined by local law enforcement;
- 13 (2) Reasonably believed to be the victim of the crime
- of child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as
- 15 determined by local law enforcement; or
- 16 (3) Less than eighteen years of age and at least
- 17 fourteen years of age and who, if under the age of fourteen,
- 18 would otherwise be reasonably believed to be a victim of
- 19 child kidnapping as defined by section 565.115 as determined
- 20 by local law enforcement.
- 21 3. The department of public safety shall develop
- 22 regions to provide the system. The department of public
- 23 safety shall coordinate local law enforcement agencies and
- 24 public commercial television and radio broadcasters to
- 25 provide an effective system. In the event that a local law
- 26 enforcement agency opts not to set up a system and an

- 27 abduction occurs within the jurisdiction, it shall notify
- 28 the department of public safety who will notify local media
- in the region.
- 30 4. The Amber alert system shall include all state
- 31 agencies capable of providing urgent and timely information
- 32 to the public together with broadcasters and other private
- 33 entities that volunteer to participate in the dissemination
- 34 of urgent public information. At a minimum, the Amber alert
- 35 system shall include the department of public safety,
- 36 highway patrol, department of transportation, department of
- 37 health and senior services, and Missouri lottery.
- 38 5. The department of public safety shall have the
- 39 authority to notify other regions upon verification that the
- 40 criteria established by the oversight committee has been met.
- 41 6. Participation in an Amber alert system is entirely
- 42 at the option of local law enforcement agencies and
- 43 federally licensed radio and television broadcasters.
- 7. Any person who knowingly makes a false report that
- 45 triggers an alert pursuant to this section is guilty of a
- 46 class A misdemeanor.
- 47 8. It shall be unlawful to discriminate against any
- 48 person because of race, color, religion, national origin,
- 49 ancestry, sex, disability, or familial status when the
- 50 department coordinates with local law enforcement agencies
- 51 and public commercial television and radio broadcasters to
- 52 provide an effective system."; and
